A statement is something that you have to think about



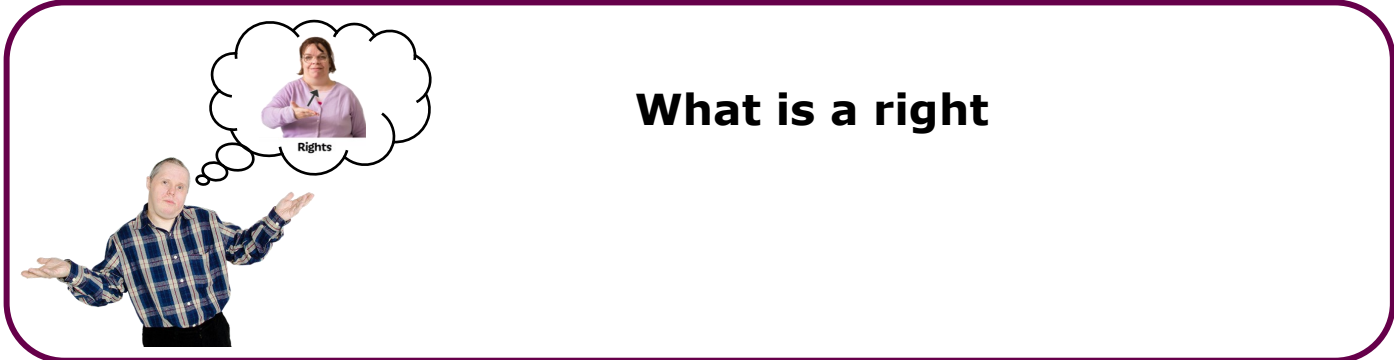
A statement can be something that you want to say

The right to learn

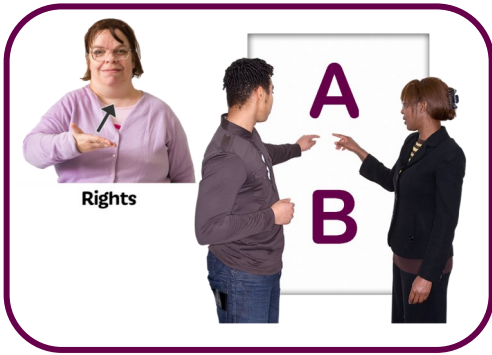


The right to health care

- medicine



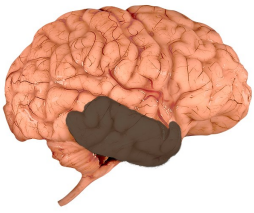
It does **not** matter where you come from

We have the right to be a part of our community the way we want to be

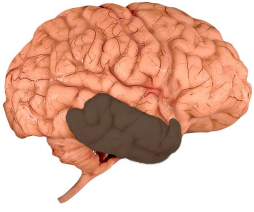


We should always be seen as who we are and **not** just as a person with dementia

We should **not** be judged



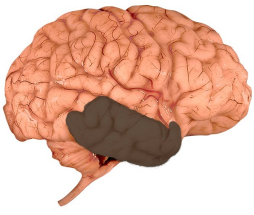
We should **not** have unfair costs

The care we get will be right for us



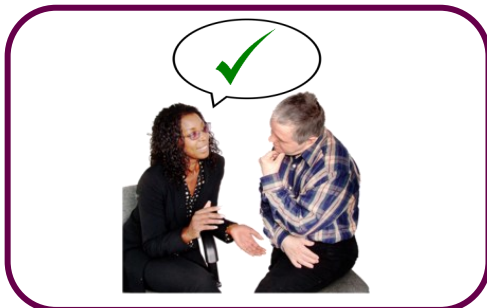
The care we get will be caring



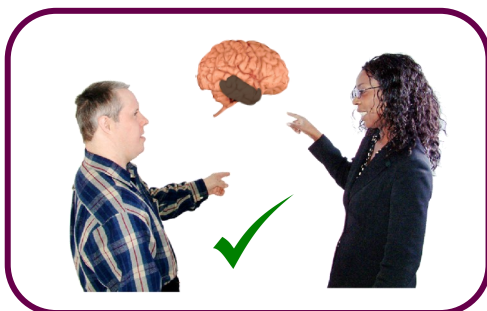
The government will give enough money for our care



We will be supported by trained and professional staff



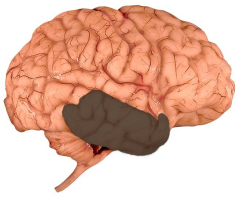
Staff will understand us

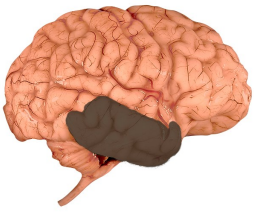

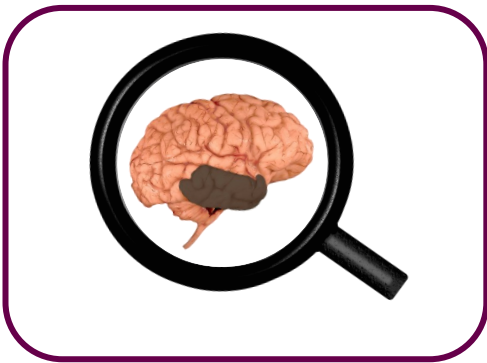

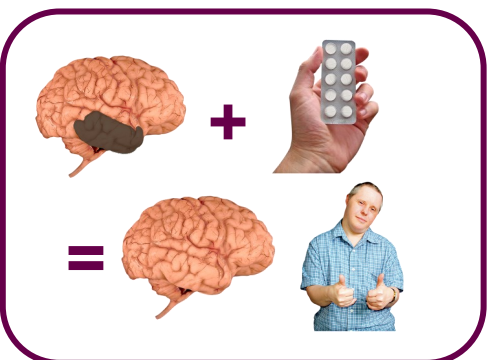
