- Each flat has a shared bathroom, living room, kitchen and dining room
- The current housemates are ten gentlemen and one lady
- Available room is accessible and on the ground floor, sharing with two gentlemen in their 50's/60's
- Accessible paved garden at the back with raised flower beds
- Within walking distance of shops
- Use of adapted vehicle
