In WRC, **Sébastien Ogier** took the victory in **Rallye Monte Carlo**, before the teams headed to snowy **Sweden** for round 2. Welsh driver **Elfyn Evans** took the victory for the first time since the Rally Japan in 2024.

In WWE, the **Royal Rumble** is on with the battles, melees and victories. **Jey Uso** won the Men's Royal Rumble from **John Cena** and **Charlotte Flair** won the Woman's Royal Rumble. You can watch the whole action on **Netflix**.

In the **Six Nations** it's round 2 and **Italy** have beaten **Wales** by 22 to 15 while **England** beat **France** by one point from 26 to 25. **Ireland** beat **Scotland** by 32 to 18.. But what will have in week 3?

Retro Computer Museum: Max's Review

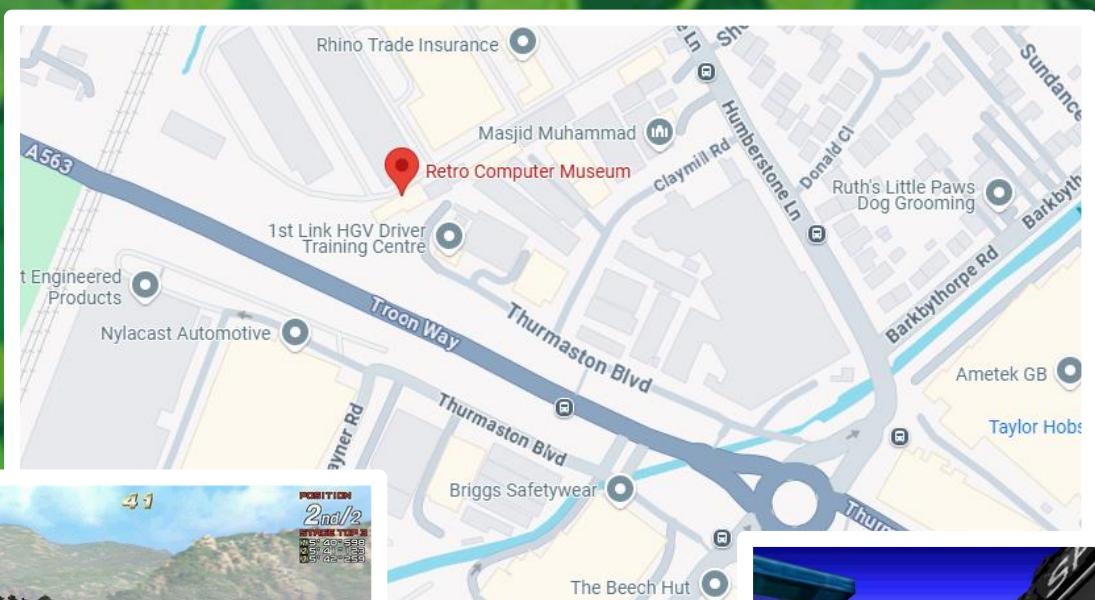
Around 3 weeks ago, I was with Becky going to a video game place called the **Retro Computer Museum** in **Thurmaston**, in **Leicester**.











































It's a great place to come and visit if you like gaming or miss your old childhood games consoles.

Last Saturday I (Max) went to the cinema to see **Dog Man**. The story is about a villainous orange cat named **Petey** who constantly terrorizes **Ohkay City**, but when two heroes got injured after a bomb exploded, the doctors joined the two together as one – one was a dog, and one was a man.. Say hello to Dog Man! The bits were funny, it was a great film and best of all, the film reached over \$87 million at the box office. It was a spin off film of **Captain Underpants** from the same universe. My review was **8.5 out of 10**.



Recently I (Scott) went to the cinema to see **Nosferatu**. It's a modern adaptation of the 1920's original and is carefully reminiscent of its predecessor. The story revolves around a bloodthirsty nocturnal **Count Orlok** who preys on lonely humans and attempts to spread his reign of disease, death and darkness across **Transylvania**.. and yes, it's loosely based on **Dracula**! It was not something I would normally choose to see, but I still enjoyed it nonetheless. My review was **9 out of 10**.

The name of this game (shadows) is relevant as this will allow players to control and manipulate shadows to gain a vital advantage over the enemy.

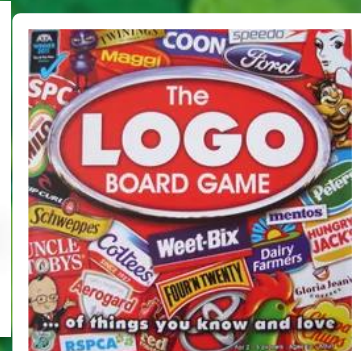
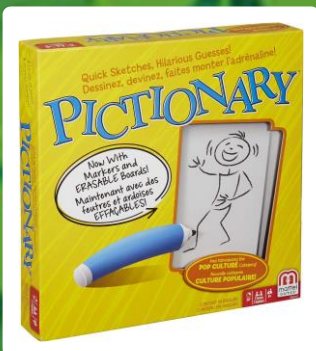

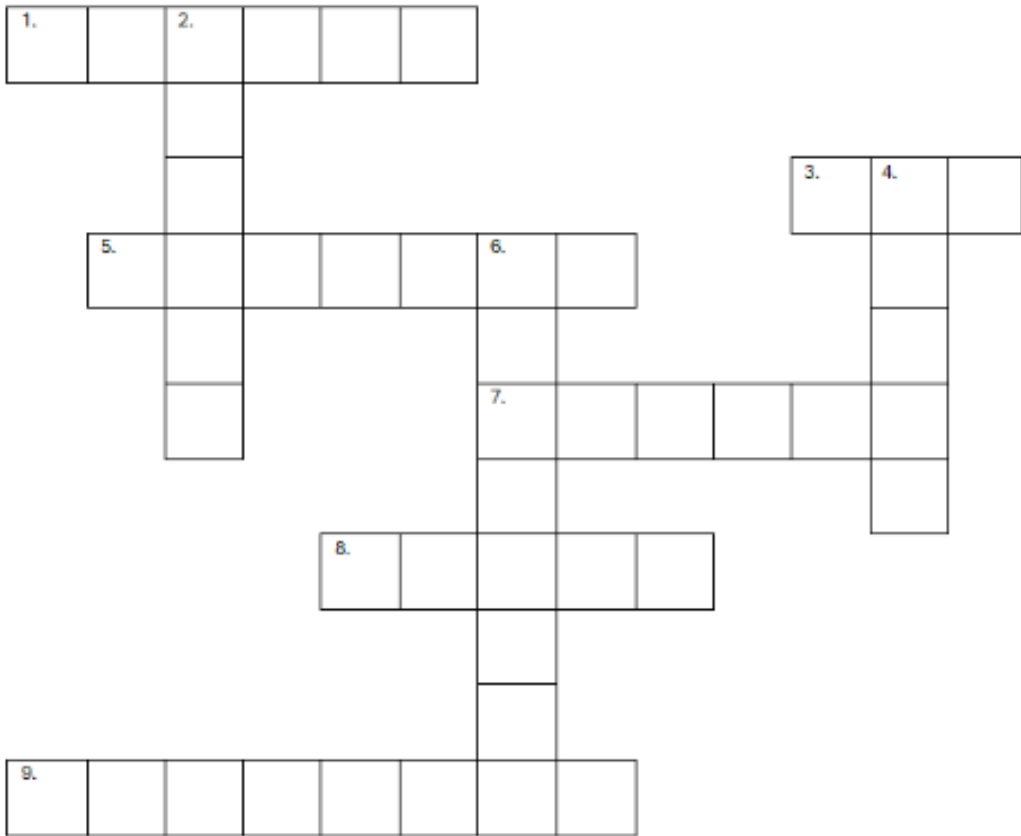
